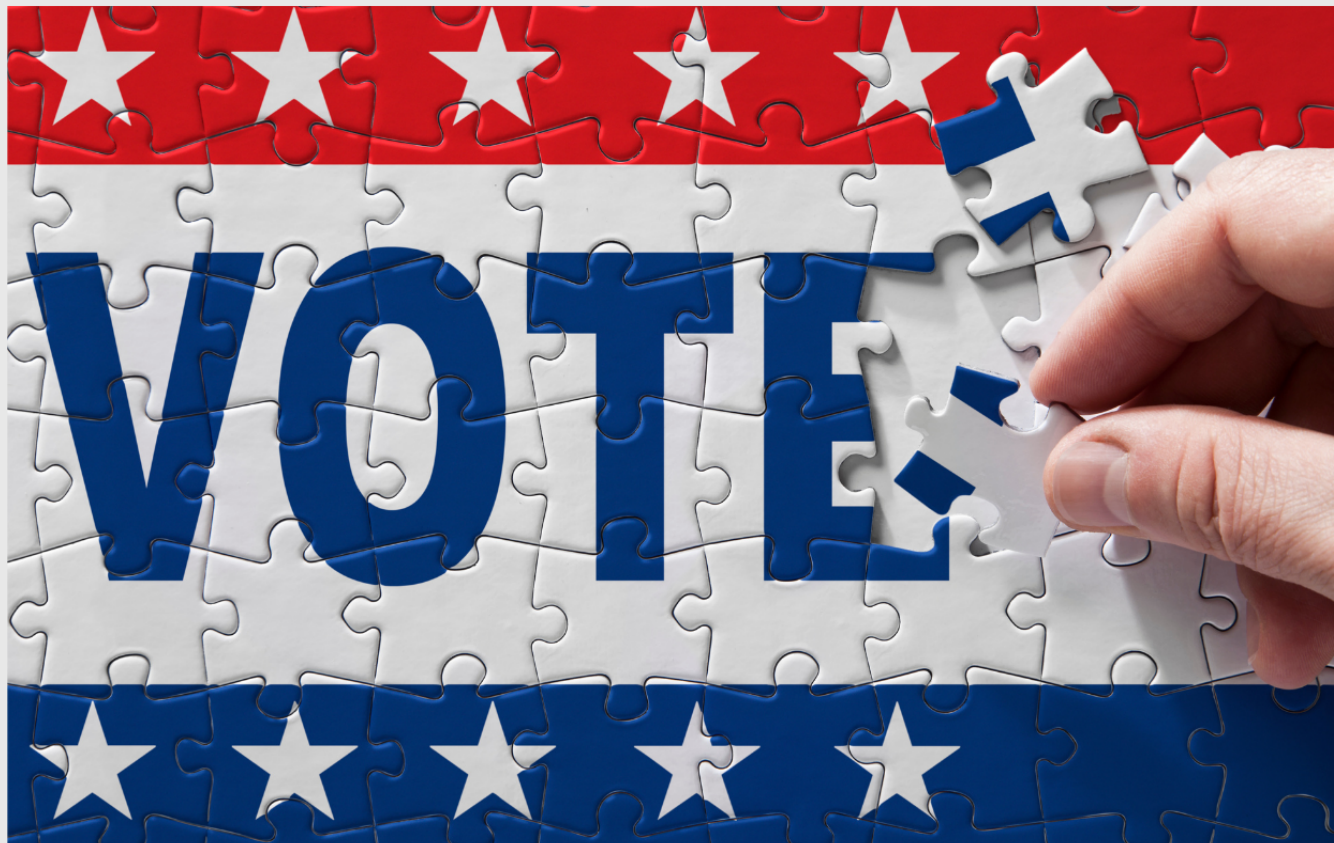

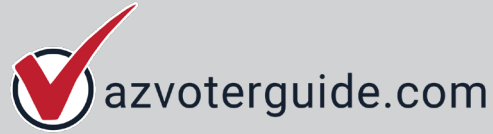

The July Primary Election decides which candidates will be on the November 5 General Election ballot.

We don't know. All candidates were provided the same opportunity to respond to the survey questions. For candidates for state office, you'll find noted the candidate's contact information made available by the Arizona Secretary of State and other public sources.
