Alliance Defending Freedom is a non-partisan legal ministry that advances the God-given right to live and speak the Truth. ADF does not take sides in any election or endorse candidates for public office. But we encourage Christians to participate fully in civic life, including when election season arrives. Each citizen's vote will help determine America's moral character.

ADF has reviewed the 2024 Arizona Voter Guide produced by the Center for Arizona Policy ("CAP") and the process used to create it. The Internal Revenue Service specifically allows ministries like CAP to create and distribute nonpartisan voter guides using candidate questionnaires. To comply with IRS guidelines, the questionnaire must be sent to every declared candidate for each office, and the questions posed to those candidates must cover a broad range of issues of interest to the citizens of a state. The questions should be clear and unbiased, the candidates should be given a reasonable amount of time to respond, and contact information should be provided for candidates who declined to respond.

Based on the information provided to us and the representations made by CAP regarding the creation of the voter guide, it is our belief that CAP has diligently endeavored to create a guide that is compliant with federal tax law and can serve as a useful tool for your church members.
